INTERMEDIARY REGISTRATION FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION OF FINLAND

To be registered as an intermediary in Football Association of Finland, intermediary needs to:

- ✓ deliver the signed intermediary declaration (link below for both legal and natural persons).
- ✓ deliver the receipt of the registration payment (payment details below)
- ✓ deliver the representation contract signed between the intermediary and the player and/or the club (details below)
- ✓ deliver the copy of intermediary's passport

Registration payment is 100 euros. Registration must be paid with following details:

Account number (FA of Finland): FI75 5789 5420 0050 63

SWIFT-code: OKOYFIHH

Message: "Edustajan rekisteröinti + name of the intermediary"

Registrations are valid until the end of the each calendar year and have to be renewed annually, meaning that all intermediary registrations will be expired at the start of a new calendar year. Intermediary must always be registered when representing a player or a club.

Each time intermediary is representing either a player or a club, the representation contract signed between the parties must be delivered to FA of Finland.

The representation contract must contain the following minimum details: the names of the parties, the scope of services, the duration of the legal relationship, the remuneration due to the intermediary, the general terms of payment, the date of conclusion, the termination provisions and the signatures of the parties.
